Author, none (Citation Maker)

Title of Book. City of Publication: Publishing Company, Copyright Year.

Note: The city can be named without the state or country if well known i.e. New York or London.

Author, one (Citation Maker)

Scieszka, Jon. The Stinky Cheese Man. New York: Viking, 1992.

Author's Last Name, First Name. Title of Book. City of Publication: Publishing Company, Copyright Year.

Author, anonymous

The Song of Roland. Trans. Frederick Bliss Luquines. New York: Macmillan, 1960.

Title of Book. [Translator (if any).] City of Publication: Publishing Company, Copyright Year.

Author, more than one work by the same author

Hansberry, Lorraine. A Raisin in the Sun. New York: Random House, 1959.

Citing previously published article in a collection

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article or Chapter." Title of Original Work. Publication information. Rpt. in Title of Secondary Source. Editor Name. Volume number. Publishing information. Page numbers.

Encyclopedia article with author (Citation Maker)

Gillingham, John. "Norman Conquest." The World Book Encyclopedia. 1998 ed.

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." Encyclopedia Title. edition.

Note: If the encyclopedia is well known, like World Book, the publication information does not have to be included. If the encyclopedia entries are alphabetical, volume and page numbers do not have to be listed.

Encyclopedia article without author

"Folk Music." Encyclopedia Americana. 1997 ed.

"Title of Article." Encyclopedia Title. edition.

Periodicals

Newspaper article (Citation Maker)

Bryant, Alice Franklin. "Our Role In The U.N." Letter to the Editor. Oregonian [Portland, OR] 15 Dec. 1997: B7, cols. 6-7.

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." [if Letter to the Editor, include that information]. Name of Newspaper [City if local and not in Newspaper Name] Date of Newspaper: Section and Page, columns.

SIRS Notebook article (or other loose-leaf collection of articles)

Freedman, Daniel G. "Ethnic Differences in Babies." Human Nature Jan. 1978: 36-43. Ethnic Groups. Ed. Eleanor Goldstein. Vol. 1. Boca Raton: SIRS, 1980. Art. 83.

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." Title of Magazine Date of Magazine: Pages. [Title of Loose-Leaf Volume in which article is reprinted, Editor (if any), Volume Number (if any), City: Publisher, Year. Article Number.]

First, list the article's original publication information. Then list the publication information for the loose-leaf volume in which the article is reprinted (shown in square brackets).
